## Pedagogies of Promise in Community-Engaged Teacher Preparation

This colloquium will examine the nine-year history of Ball State University's nationally-recognized Schools Within the Context of Community project, specifically focusing on community-engaged pedagogies used in the development of culturally-sustaining, equity-focused, socially just future teachers, and their impact on candidates, the community, schools, and P-5 student learning. Audience members will be encouraged to consider how this model of community-engaged teacher preparation has relevance for their individual institutions and the community contexts in which they are situated.

**Eva Zygmunt** is the Helen Gant Elmore Distinguished Professor of Elementary Education and director of the Schools Within the Context of Community program of teacher preparation at Ball State University.

**Patricia Clark** is professor of Early Childhood Education, chair of the Department of Elementary Education, and cofounder of the Schools Within the Context of Community community-engaged program of teacher preparation at Ball State University.
