Field Experience Assignment(s):

Week 1: Observation and Assessments

During the first field experience week, students will complete two tasks. First, each student will assess oral reading fluency and decoding for 2 students selected with the clinical educator (CE). Second, each student will complete an observation of their CE's literacy instruction. Placement partners can collaborate, but each student will turn in her/his own assignment. A format for the description will be provided on the course Canvas page. In addition, students should work with the CE to discuss selection of two texts for upcoming lessons (a *grade-level* text for shared reading, and an *above grade-level* text for interactive read aloud) for whole group lessons during the Mondays described below.

Six (6) Mondays of Field Time: Tier 1 Whole Group Lesson

You and your partner will plan two Tier 1 whole group literacy lessons – a Shared Reading lesson and an Interactive Read Aloud with Sentence Composing. Both lessons will be fully planned and submitted for grading. During the placement days on Mondays (either 4/11/22 or 4/25/22), you and your partner will select and team-teach <u>one</u> of these lessons (~30-40 minutes): either the whole-group shared reading lesson with a before, during, and after-reading structure OR the interactive read aloud followed by a sentence composing lesson. In addition, students will work with the CE to identify a small group of <u>up to 6 students</u> and a text for the two small group lessons during Week 3 and should leave with a copy of the text.

Week 2: Tier 2 Small Group Lessons

During the second field experience week, each student will (a) teach one 30-40-minute lesson and, (b) conduct a structured observation of his or her partner's teaching using an Observation and Coaching Form. One student will teach a small-group guided reading lesson to the group identified. The other student will conduct a small-group genre-based writing lesson based on the text used in guided reading for the <u>same</u> group of students. These two lessons can be implemented on different days, but the reading lesson should come first.
