Maintenance and loss of heritage language among children (Ages 4-9) of Chinese immigrants in the UK -A qualitative study on five Chinese immigrants' families.

- Conducted semi-structured interviews with parents from five Chinese immigrant families to collect data concerning information on FLP and their stand on monolingual, bilingual, and multilingual policies of language use in homes
- Used Nvivo to carry out thematic analysis to deductively analyze the qualitative interview data to evaluate the current status and the development of the Chinese heritage language among Chinese immigrant households in the UK
- Results indicated a need to develop a learning environment within and outside the home that does not drown out the cultural heritage of children: 1) parents must implement practices that serve to influence the children to learn their native languages positively, and 2) educators within the schools that serve Chinese immigrant children encourage the use of Chinese languages to ensure there is an increased level of cultural heritage among the children.
